

Why should I upgrade to Easy-Off Flexible Tarp Stops?

Standard galvanized steel tarp stops attach to the fixed tube to stop the tarp at the edge of the box. (Offset styles store the tarp off to the side of the top rail.) When a standard tarp stop catches on a loader or auger, the roll tube and tarp can be damaged and the stop itself bent or broken – not to mention the resulting damage to the loader or auger.

If an **Easy-Off Flexible Tarp Stop** is hit, it flexes – even in subzero temperatures. This flexibility could save you or your customer from having to replace the tarp or fixed tube and minimizes damage to the auger or whatever is hit.

All of our flexible stops create a self-cleaning top rail. Grain simply falls through the space between the fixed tube and the box. This is important because trapped grain rots and can cause premature tarp wear.

The **Easy-Off Flexible Tarp Stop** is available in a standard upright style as well as 6-inch offset models. Equipped with embedded safety plates, these stops are interchangeable with aluminum easy-off styles.
